We are currently recruiting a General Assistant to join our staff team at Lendrick Muir. Previous experience in catering or housekeeping is not essential as full training and guidance will be provided but evidence of an interest in either of these areas would be advantageous.

As a General Assistant, you will be involved in provision of the catering functions offered by the Centre, ensuring that all guest areas are maintained to a high standard and in caring for the needs of guests and other tasks as required. You need to be flexible and willing to learn new skills and work within different areas of guest service provision at Lendrick Muir. Support will be given to study for an SVQ Level 2 in Hospitality Service through on-the-job assessment and work-based training.

You will be expected to work 40 hours a week, usually between 8.30am and 5.30pm, but there will be occasions when you will need to work into the early evening, and occasionally on a Saturday or Sunday.

For this post we will provide you with food and accommodation plus a monthly allowance of £200 and all training/qualification costs.

You must also be able to demonstrate a strong commitment to SU Scotland's ethos, working principles and vision. It is also a Genuine Occupational Requirement, in terms of the Employment Equality (Religion or Belief) Regulations 2003, that the post-holder demonstrates a personal faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour.
