The Scripture Union Northern Ireland Podcast exists to encourage and resource the local Church in our joint mission of making God's Good news known to children, young people and families. It is a monthly podcast that lasts approximately 30 minutes and in the past year we have looked at topics such as 'people development', 'partnership', 'Illustrated faith', 'Prayer'. Following the characters Chris, Holly Beth and Sam through ups and downs of discussing the Christian faith with their friends, young people will learn the value of a conversational, question based approach that is both robust but also positive.
